1. School's Context

Suneden Specialist School is an Independent non-denominational Specialist School with a registered charity status. It is located in Mitchell Park, South Australia. In 2017, Suneden had an enrolment of 68 students with ages ranging from 5 until 21. All of the students had an intellectual disability and many students had dual diagnoses, including autism, Down Syndrome, cerebral palsy, and other chromosomal conditions.

2. Teacher Standards and Qualifications

All teachers satisfied the requirements of the South Australian Teachers Registration Board including relevant child protection training and criminal history checks. 85% of the teachers have more two or more qualifications and 31% have a Masters qualification in Education.
